dear students

we would like to share with you some important information about the current situation in the schools:

- There will be no classes at school until Feb. 12, 2021.
- Classes will be held at a distance. This means all students will receive regular assignments and will be required to complete them at home.
- Children must attend all video conferences on time.
- If there are any problems with the internet, report to your school. There is an opportunity to participate in distance learning at school.
- There is a possibility to borrow an iPad at school. If this is necessary, report to the school.

Important!

It is compulsory to attend school! This means that all students

- must work Monday through Friday as they would on a normal school day
- must be excused in writing if they cannot attend a video conference or are sick
- be graded for assignments turned in and their cooperation (there will be grades).

Please, dear parents, help your children successfully get through this difficult time by facilitating a learning atmosphere at home and supporting your children.
